

Postcards

Thank you for joining us in this important campaign.

Here's what you will need:

- Paper in your printer
- A pair of scissors
- A glue stick
- A postal stamp
- A pen

How this works:

- Pick two family photos that you would like to send. One will go to Premier Gordon Campbell and the other to Carole James, Leader of the Opposition.
- Measure your photos. They usually come in standard sizes: 3" x 5", 4" x 6" or 5" x 7". You can mail any size photo in this campaign but it must be smaller than 6" x 9" to qualify for the standard postal rate of 51 cents.
- We have prepared the backs of the postcards in the standard sizes. Click on the size that matches your photos.

This should open an Adobe Acrobat file on your computer. It should look something like this:

- Print this file.

- Follow the dotted lines and cut the postcard backs to make sure they fit your photos.
- Get your glue stick out and glue each postcard back to the back of your photos.
- In the lines provided you can customize your message, add your name, whatever you would like.
- Affix the postal stamp.
- Pop it in the nearest mailbox. Congratulations, you've made a difference.
